



EVENTING
FEI EVENTING RIDERS'S WORLD RANKING LIST - 2012 OLYMPIC GAMES

The point system to be used for establishing the FEI 2011-2012 Olympic Riders Ranking – Eventing is based on riders achieving FEI Qualifying Results in 3 and 4 star level events (CCI & CICs) and covers the period from **1 March 2011 to 1 March 2012**.

Points to top 25% of starters in the competition as per current point system.

The FEI Olympic Eventing Ranking – Point System is as follows:

Each rider finishing the competition with a MER will receive the same number of points			
2 nd rider	4	3	2

For the Olympic Qualification, the Olympic Ranking list would be based on:

- 5 best results per rider (as set by the IOC).
- Ranking list would cover the period from 1 March 2011 – 1 March 2012 (as set by the IOC).
- Only events counting for the riders to obtain Olympic Eligibility CCI 3* & CIC 3* and up (see list on web-site).
- Only Minimum Eligibility Requirements would count for the Olympic rankings.
- Riders competing at the 2 Continental Championships of 3 stars level counting for the Olympic Team Qualification, the 2011 CH-EU-C Luhmühlen (GER), and the Asia Pacific Championship selected event would all receive points as for CH-CCI 3* (111 points allocated to 1st place).
